# ICON CONTAINER GROMMET INSPECTION Issue Date: November 27, 2007

Status: Precautionary

Identification: All ICON Harness/Container.

Part Number: P120

Manufactured After and Including 01 September 2007

Background: A report back from the field revealed that there were some

damaged Grommets on an ICON Container. The ICON was returned to the manufacturer where it was determined that the Grommets had been damaged by the Grommet

Press.


The Damage can be seen on the inside of the Grommet where the Closing Tool has scratched the Inside Surface of the Grommet. The seating of the Grommet needs to be inspected

to ensure correct and flush seating of the Grommet.

This could well be an isolated incident, but as a matter of precaution Aerodyne is recommending all Grommets on the ICONs listed in the Identification paragraph above

be Inspected.
